Dr. Joseph McDonald is a clinical faculty member at the University of Utah Medical School and Medical Physicist for the Georg E Wahlen Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center Salt Lake City. He also serves on the American Board of Health Physics Part II Examination Board and is a member of the Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Emergency Radiological Response Team (MERRT).

Dr. McDonald performed his dissertation research at Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory (LLNL) while obtaining his PhD at Western Michigan University and continued with basic research in Nuclear Physics at LLNL for 21 years authoring or coauthoring more than 85 peer-reviewed articles before changing careers to medical/health physics. From 2009 to 2019 he worked as the Radiation Safety Officer and Medical Physicist at the Georg E Wahlen Department of Veterans affairs Medical Center.

Dr. McDonald is certified to perform Mammography inspections and is certified as a Health Physicist/Medical physicist in Kentucky, Virginia, West Virginia, and Utah specializing in MRI, CT, Diagnostic x-ray, and Nuclear Medicine.
